Scavenger Hunt Rules & Regulations

September 28 - October 22, 2023

What is the Scavenger Hunt?

There are Take Action QR Codes hidden at Community Partners throughout the community. The objective is to find and scan the hidden QR Codes. Each code is linked to a quick video containing the location's unique identifier needed for your entry form.

How do I play?

Register to participate at <https://www.favorhouse.org/take-action-scavengerhunt>

Participants can register as an individual or as a team, but not both. Anyone who registers as both an individual and as part of a team will be disqualified.

Upon registration, you will receive the list of the Scavenger Hunt locations and an entry form. You will have until Sunday, October 22, 2023 to visit each location, find the QR code (or codes) hidden there, and complete your entry form.

Each Scavenger Hunt location has hidden a sign like this one:



Find the sign and use your mobile device to scan the QR code. Watch the quick video and note the unique code on your entry form.

All locations will have at least one hidden QR code. Some locations have multiple hidden codes. And still other locations have bonus points available. The bonus points information is located at the end of the one-minute video under the revealed hunt code.

Points are earned by completing the entry form with the appropriate hunt codes for the Scavenger Hunt location.

To complete the Scavenger Hunt, you must submit your entry form before 11:59 p.m. on October 22, 2023. Late entries will not be accepted.

How am I scored?

Your entry form must be submitted electronically before 11:59 p.m. on Sunday, October 22, 2023. Late entries will be disqualified.

Your entry form will be scored based on the point value assigned to each unique code.

Winners will be announced at the Take Action to End DV Celebration Lunch on Thursday, October 26, 2023 at the Bayview Community Center.

All decisions by the judges are final.

Are there prizes?

Yes. There will be prizes awarded in the following categories:

Youth (ages 5 - 15)
Individuals (ages 16+)
Teams

Participants must submit their entry form before 11:59 p.m. on Sunday, October 22, 2023 to qualify for prizes.

Participants with the most points win. If participants in a category tie for points, the time the entry form was submitted will be the tie breaking factor.

Prizes will be given at the Take Action Celebration Lunch on Thursday, October 26, 2023 at the Bayview Community Center. Winners do not need to be present to receive prizes.

What else do I need to know?

The Take Action Scavenger Hunt is all about having fun and learning ways to recognize signs of domestic violence and where to find help. Don't let your competitive instincts drive you to ruin other people's chances to win. This means no sabotaging, no removing the hidden QR code from its location, no cheating, no stealing, and no copying other people's work. Any of these activities will lead to disqualification.

Scavenger Hunt locations do not need to be completed in order.

Once your entry form has been submitted, you cannot add or change answers.

The Scavenger Hunt locations are local businesses and activities. When talking or interacting with strangers, business owners, or community workers, all participants must be polite and respectful.

Any illegal activity is forbidden. Vandalism, trespassing, shoplifting, creating a nuisance, or other illegal activity while participating in the Scavenger Hunt will disqualify the participant and/or team.
